Dear Parent or Guardian,

In collaboration with Delphi Community School Corporation, we are pleased to provide a Delphi Public Library Digital Access Card for your elementary, middle, or high school student.

Designed with students in mind, a Digital Access Card allows students easy access to our electronic databases and eBook resources at home or at school. Digital Access Cards are free and are distributed to eligible students as determined by the school. Students do not have to visit the public library to sign up for this card, and once students receive them they may begin to use them immediately. The cards will be distributed through the school librarians and will be available to your student throughout their entire school enrollment, from K to grade 12. There is no risk of lost materials or financial responsibility, as all content is electronic.

To make this new service more easily accessible for students, we have developed a Student Portal, which you can access via <http://www.delphilibrary.org/index.php?page=studentportal>. We encourage you to have a look at these resources and be involved in your student's selection and use. We have created some age-appropriate groupings of our resources and downloadable items. We plan to build on this collection and will be updating the portal regularly.

Again, this Digital Access Card allows access only to electronic databases and eBook resources. A full service (traditional) library card is needed for full access to all library materials.
